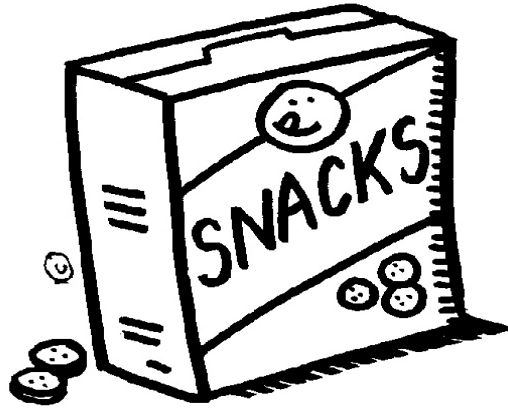
ELECTRONIC DEVICES
