

PODER / PASS Re-Opening Plan

7-8-20

Below is a framework that will be implemented for the upcoming school year depending on the trend and number of infections. Information about additional modifications will be forthcoming through the next few weeks.

Tier 1 – Students return to school with modifications

- Back-to-school will be pushed back to align with LCSD 1. School will now start for both PODER / PASS on **August 24th**. *Please see the updated calendar on the website.
- **Cloth face masks** will be required at arrival, dismissal, in the hall, and front office. Students may remove masks once they are seated at their desks or when outside.
- Half of each class will eat lunch in the lunchroom, while the other half will return to the classroom. These groups will alternate each week.
- Specific rooms in each building will be designated for sick students.
- Parents will be called for pickup immediately if any symptoms are present, including fever however slight, coughing, nausea, headache, shortness of breath, vomiting, unusual fatigue, body aches, etc. Students will await pickup with a mask in one of the designated rooms.
- An area around the front office desk will be designated as a buffer. Students / parents should not step inside this buffer.
- Only one school phone will be designated for students to call home. This phone will be sanitized after each call.
- Students in grades 3rd-12th will given a plastic glove and a sanitizer wipe at the end of each day to sanitize their desks and pencils.

- After each computer session, students will be given a plastic glove and sanitizer wipe to sanitize their computer.
- Students in grades Kinder-2nd will have staff members assist with sanitizer wipe-downs.
- Students without their own water bottles will be given their own paper cups for water.
- All parent conferences will take place virtually via Google Meet, unless there are extenuating circumstances. **Parent conferences will not be held at school this year.**
- **Back-to-School Nights** will be split into groups. Please see the school Academic Calendar for designated times for each group.
- Options for **Distance Learning** will be made available for parents who opt to keep their students at home. Lessons will be streaming and/or available on Google Classroom along with curriculum materials.

Tier 2 – Hybrid of in school service & distance learning from home

If an elevated number of COVID-19 cases is detected, the school will move to a hybrid plan with a combination of in-school service and distance learning from home. Some or all students in a class may shift back to a distance learning plan and rotate in on certain days. Specific classrooms might be re-located temporarily while social distancing is increased.

Tier 3 – School Building is Closed

If an outbreak is imminent, or State / local directives require, the school will close down and students will revert back to the Distance Learning Plan previously in place until further notice.

Thank you for your cooperation and patience as we work to get students back to school in the safest way possible.
